

Barry City Council  
Regular Meeting  
May 6, 2019

Mayor Rennecker called the regular monthly meeting of the Barry City Council to order at 7 p.m. He then led all present in the Pledge of Allegiance. All elected officials were present except Bruce Kendall.

Debbie Harshman made a motion to approve the minutes from the April meeting and Bob Dieker seconded the motion, Motion carried with 5 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.

Steve Schultz made a motion to approve payment of the bills and Scott Harris seconded the motion. Motion carried with 5 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.

Officer Steve Lowry from the Pike County Sheriff department gave the police report.

He asked if the code enforcements have been taken care of.

Robert Snyder gave the Public Works Director report. He said the city clean up went good and they have started pressure washing the pool and will soon be ready to paint. Almost all of the fence is up around the pool and are going to try to get hydrants flushed before Memorial Day.

Jeff Hogge gave the City Administrator report. He said the CCR reports have been sent into EPA and has attended meeting with American Fresh Water Fish as well as contractors. They are about 30 days out from getting EPA approval. Delivered TIF facade applications to area businesses and the new flow meters were installed at sewer plant on April 10, 2019. The videoing of the sewers are tentatively scheduled for June 11 – 13.

Steve Schultz gave the Revolving Loan Fund Committee report. Cindy Galinis of Tiny's Place requested loan in amount of \$9313.24 for new floor in the building. The loan would be at 3% interest up to 5 years. Steve Schultz made recommendation to loan Cindy the money for new floor and Bob Dieker seconded the motion. Roll call taken:

Motion carried with 5 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent to loan Cindy Galinis the money for a new floor at Tiny's Place.

Debbie Harshman gave the Parks & Recreation committee report. Debbie said the pool is scheduled to open May 25 and close August 11. Swim lessons have been scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup> thru June 20<sup>th</sup> from 5:30 P.M. to 6:30 P.M. and July 8<sup>th</sup> thru July 11<sup>th</sup> from 11 A.M to 12 P.M. The price for pool parties have been left the same as last and pool passes are \$75 for first pass \$55 for second \$35 for third pass and \$25 for each remaining pass from same family, punch cards remain \$25. There have been 7 applications turned in for lifeguards. All are returning guards except for two. Robert Snyder has replaced the lights at the pool. Steve Schultz made a motion to approve the lifeguards and the prices. Marynel Corton seconded the motion. Motion carried with 5 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.

Council discussed hiring the summer help. Debbie Harshman made a motion to hire Dylan Swartz and Aaron Schultz for summer help and Scott Harris seconded the motion.

Motions carried with 4 ayes, 1 absent and 1 abstain to hire Dylan and Aaron for summer helpers.

Attorney Tad Brenner swore in the new at large aldermen: Lance Kendrick, Bob Dieker and Steve Schultz. Lance replaces Debbie Harshman and Bob and Steve are returning aldermen.

Mayor Rennecker presented Debbie Harshman with a plaque for all of years on Council.

Mayor Rennecker re-appointed City Officers: Interim Mayor – Steve Schultz; City Administrator – Jeff Hogge; Public Works Director – Robert Snyder; Collector- Sandra Brown; Attorney – Tad Brenner. Bob Dieker made a motion to approve the re-appointments and Scott Harris seconded the motion. Motion carried with 5 ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.
